

Meals, hotel, transportation, and parking fees are not included in the registration fee. Additional fees apply for the mission trips and luau tickets for additional guests. Hotel Reservations: You must reserve your hotel room directly through the hotel. The conference hotel is the Sheraton Waikiki. Standard rooms with 2 queen, or a king bed, balcony, and view are \$195+ tax per night for two persons with an additional charge of \$65 per night for each additional adult (children stay free). The Sheraton Manor House Annex, adjacent to the hotel, has smaller rooms with 2 single beds/no view and can accommodate up to two people for \$96 + tax per night.

Our block of hotel rooms is limited so please book early. A customized online hotel registration website is available at www.starwoodmeeting.com/Book/umw or call toll free (800)782-9488 and mention the conference name when booking to receive the conference block rates. To enjoy your stay longer, the Sheraton Waikiki guarantees the same rates 3 days prior and 3 days after the meeting date, subject to availability at the time of reservation.

Child Care: Child Care for children ages 5 to 12 is available for an additional fee for persons staying at the Sheraton Waikiki Hotel. Please make necessary arrangements with the hotel directly when booking your room.

Mission Trips: All three mission trips are offered Friday, April 4 in both the morning and afternoon. Attendees can choose to take one or two mission trips. Due to the program schedule, Voting Delegates, Women's Division nominees, Core Planning Group & Committee on Nominations nominees will only be able to take a.m. trips.

Transportation/Parking:

Attendees are responsible for their own transportation to and from the airport. The Airport Waikiki Express shuttle bus is currently \$9 one way (\$15 round trip); it leaves the airport frequently and stops at all of the hotels. A taxi costs approximately \$25 one way. Hotel parking fees: For hotel guests, there is a \$15/day in house self-parking fee with unlimited in/out parking opportunities. For attendees not staying at the hotel, a single entry/exit banquet parking for up to 12 hours is available for \$5.

Cancellation Policy:

Upon receipt of written notice and request for a refund prior to the event, the quadrennial meeting registration fee, minus a \$50 cancellation fee may be refunded by the registrar or upon consideration by the Core Planning Group. Registrations may be transferred, without penalty, to another attendee who is not already registered, provided written request for transfer of registration fee is received by the registrar prior to the event.
